Dorridge cricket club offers children and adults in the area a great opportunity to learn and then play cricket. The new pavilion will be a fantastic local resource used by hundreds

The Knowle and Dorridge cricket club is at the heart of the community and provides a fundamental unique benchmark of quality for the local area. It is imperative that we collectively continue to invest in this privilege to ensure it's future is sustainable.

It is not clear whether or not the DDRA bid has land owner permission to proceed and no consultation has been completed with park users to establish whether or not a tarmac path here is more of a priority than playground improvements. It may also be inappropriate given that Dorridge Wood has Local Nature Reserve status (a statutory designation) and it should be noted that this path was re-laid in 2018 following ERDF work completed by the Council. Replacement of this path is therefore in my opinion no different to replacement of a a piece of play equipment that has reached the end of its useful life. This is my local park and the statement that 'the Council probably won't listen' is not a fact. I have heard people complain more about muddy areas around the play equipment and poor facilities compared to Knowle. Complete replacement of something old with something new, more fit for purpose is not simply maintenance - whether it is a tarmac path to replace a self-binding stone path, a new roof or a more modern multi-play unit with a higher play value that is more accessible and inclusive than the old. At least 4 out of the 8 projects appear to be replacement of old for new so they are either all valid or not. I think your comments about the Council's bid are very unfair given that Dorridge Park is available for all local residents to enjoy (unlike the cricket clubs and allotments) and I am concerned that Solihull Council will have no option but to remove play equipment at the end of its useful life as they do not have any capital budget for new play equipment and desperately need external funding like NCIL, whether they apply for it directly or through a community group as was done for Knowle Park last year.

The DDRA proposal in principle sounds like it could deliver the widest community benefit. It is helpful, therefore, to assess this submission against the DDRA's recent successful bid for the path in Bentley Heath park.

As it currently stands, this new proposal lacks sufficient rigour and clarity of detail in a number of important aspects, eg: level of community support (noting also that the bid reads as written by an individual using 'l', in contrast to the Bentley Heath proposal); the solution proposed - tarmac or a more natural Breedon gravel as used previously for Bentley Heath?; firm quotations from a nominated contractor. Given the likely size of this path compared to Bentley Heath, intuitively the estimated cost seems an unrealistic under-estimate.

The bidder should be encouraged to consider re-submitting a proposal next year, having first gathered more robust supporting information and actively consulted to evidence community support (as happened for the Bentley Heath proposal).
